Jreasury at Petra

Carved out of a sandstone rock face, the Jreasury is the most elaborate ruin at Petra. It's the first sight to greet visitors as they emerge from the long and narrow gorge which marks the entrance to the city and it took our breath away.

#### Petra Visit and the Nabati Show

Jhe experience begins by encountering two guards at the 'Siq', the narrow gorge that forms the entrance to the city. Once visitors have made their way past the amphitheater and deeper into Petra, those visitors are treated to soldiers performing a poetic dance designed to transport spectators back in time and reveal 'the Art of Warfare'. Jhey say you have not seen Petra if you have not hiked the 800 steps up to one of Petra's most Petra's most awe-inspiring monuments: the Monastery. carved from a chunk of mountain

nearly an hour's climb northwest of the city center.

### Day 6 Dead Sea

Post breakast we drive through the wonderful landscapes and mountains and through the King Hussain highway towards the beautiful shores of the Dead sea. A spectacular natural wonder - the Dead Sea is the Earth's lowest elevation point. It's aptly named the Dead Sea as the water is devoid of life and with salt levels 4 times higher than the rest of the world's oceans, it's a case of floating rather than swimming! Jhe water contains 35 minerals and these, together with the rich mud on its shoreline, make it a spa treat for the skin.

the dead sea.

#### Day 7 Dead Sea

Post swimming we proceed to the hot springs by bus. Jhe Ma'in Hot Springs are a series of hot mineral springs and waterfalls located between Madaba and the Dead Sea and the waters are said to have healing properties for aches and pains. PostLunch we will visit Mt. Nebo.

Mount Nebo is, according to ancient tradition, the place from which Moses saw

the Promised Land before he died and at 700 metres above sea level, the view of the

Holy Land and the Jordan Valley are spectacular. It's the reported death and

burial site of Moses and the church with the mosaic is a highlight of a visit.

Evening back to hotel followed by dinner.
